

## **Hassayampa Boardwalk Covid-19 Plan**

### **COVID-19 WARNING**

We have taken enhanced health and safety measures for you, our other Guests, and Team Members.

You must follow all posted instructions while visiting The Hassayampa Boardwalk.

An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, senior citizens and guests with underlying medical conditions are especially vulnerable. By visiting The Hassayampa Boardwalk you voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19.

Help keep each other healthy and safe.

**Measures being requested of all boardwalk guests, to reduce the risk of exposure to disease:**

Masks required

- All guests will be asked to wear a mask if unable to maintain the proper distance.
  
- If a guest refuses to comply with this plan the Hassayampa Boardwalk organizer will ask them to kindly leave.
  
- Guests will be asked to stay home if they are exhibiting symptoms such as fever, runny nose, dry cough, shortness of breath, fatigue, body aches.

Signage

-Health and Safety Reminders will be posted at the gate and throughout the park.

- Maintain Physical Distancing
- Wash/Sanitize Your Hands Often
- When Coughing or Sneezing Cover your Mouth & Nose
- Avoid Touching Eyes, Nose, or Mouth

Seek Medical Attention if you are experiencing flu-like symptoms

**Measures being taken by management, employees, and vendors to promote good hygiene and reduce the risk of exposure to disease:**

Mask Required.

-All staff are required to wear a face covering and gloves when serving guests.

Sanitation

- All amusement ride seats, handrails, and headrests will be sanitized between users.

-Sanitation stations will be installed throughout the property for use by the public and employees.

-Outdoor dining areas will be sanitized after each use, and tables will be placed a minimum of 6' apart.

-A team of employees will be directed to sanitize restroom facilities and high traffic surfaces such as food service counters, dining areas etc. every hour.
